Please accept this letter as notice that Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC (Transco) hereby withdraws the Coastal Wetlands Individual Permit, Waterfront Development Upland Individual Permit and Waterfront Development In-Water Individual Permit applications (LUP 190002). The reason for this withdrawal is to provide the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) with additional time to comply with the timeframes established by N.J.A.C. 7:7-26.6(e).

Transco will be submitting new permit applications for the Coastal Wetlands Individual Permit, Waterfront Development Upland Individual Permit and Waterfront Development In-Water Individual Permit in the coming days.

On August 15, 2019, the Department advised Transco that its Flood Hazard Area Individual Permit application (LUP 190001) was considered complete for review. This established October 29, 2019, as the Department's 90-day deadline for issuance of a permitting decision. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-21.3(b), Transco hereby requests an extension of this deadline by up to 30 calendar days.
