## Stop NESE Pipeline and Compressor Station

Williams-Transco's Northeast Supply Enhancement (NESE) Project proposes:

- Construction of a gas-powered compressor station in Franklin Township
- 3.5 miles of connecting pipeline through Old Bridge & Sayreville
- 23 miles of new pipeline under the Raritan Bay/New York Harbor

## Impacts:

- Construction and operation of the proposed compressor station will create air pollution and water pollution by releasing toxic chemicals.
- The higher pressure of the gas coming from compressor stations increases the risk of leaks, fires & explosions.
- Pipelines leak methane, which directly contributes to climate change.
- Chemicals in fracked gas corrode pipelines much faster than expected.
- A pipeline under the Raritan Bay will dredge up toxins buried for decades.

- Inland and coastal risks include increased flooding and destruction of critical wetlands and habitats.
- Gases and toxins emitted by compressor stations are known to cause both acute and chronic health impacts. The proposed compressor station would emit toxic chemicals that can cause: cancer, childhood leukemia, birth defects, developmental delays, immunological disorders, increased risk for heart attacks and strokes, neurological issues, lung diseases including asthma, sleep issues with breathing disorders, kidney disease, and premature death.
- Small particulate matter from burning fossil fuels, combines with toxins and carcinogens and brings them deep inside the body.

We do not need another massive Fossil Fuel project to pollute our air and water.
